Pin-to-pin compatible with the Intel 815E chipset, the 815EP chipset is a highly scalable design for Intel® Pentium® III processor platforms.

The 815EP chipset is an ideal solution for power users who prefer to choose their own graphics. With support for an industry-wide range of external AGP 4X, 2X or 1X graphics cards, as well as PCI cards, the 815EP chipset forms a flexible platform for powerful multimedia performance.

- PC133 SDRAM increases peak memory bandwidth to 1GB/s over 800MB/s on PC100 SDRAM, and is available in a variety of memory configurations.
- AGP 4X provides the necessary graphics bandwidth to ensure the highest graphics performance and photo-realistic 3D. Support for AGP cards enables world-class multimedia solutions that satisfy a wide range of customers.

The smart integration in the Intel 815EP chipsets I/O Controller Hub (ICH2) features internal LAN capability and two USB controllers supporting four USB ports. With support for six channels of AC97 audio and the ability to make the most of soft audio/modem technology, the 815EP chipset delivers an ideal solution for innovative new form factors.

Further flexibility can be achieved by taking advantage of the Communication and Network Riser (CNR) card option that allows audio, modem, and/or LAN configuration on a single base board design. The integrated LAN capability utilizes Intel® SingleDriver™ technology, with full backward compatibility for increased quality and reliability.

The 815EP chipset delivers a discrete graphics solution that enables easy upgrades to meet the performance and reliability requirements of the most demanding customers.

- The 82815EP Memory Controller Hub (MCH) provides the CPU interface supporting Intel® Pentium® III or Intel Celeron™ processors. The MCH also provides the PC133/100 SDRAM and AGP 4X interfaces. The AGP interface allows graphics controllers to access main memory at over 1 GB/s—twice that of previous AGP platforms.



- The enhanced 82801BA I/O Controller Hub (ICH2) delivers twice the I/O bandwidth over traditional bridge architecture and provides dedicated data paths to fully optimize the additional bandwidth.
- Two USB controllers double the bandwidth to 24Mbps across four ports, representing a significant increase over integrated 1-4 port hubs at 12Mbps.
- AC97 audio supports full surround sound with up to six channels and a soft modem implementation.
- The Integrated LAN Capability can be enabled for three distinct networking environments (1Mbps Home PNA, 10/100Mbps LAN and managed 10/100Mbps LAN). All three solutions utilize Intel SingleDriver technology, with a common set of drivers that simplify network complexity and increase ease of deployment.
- ATA100 Hard Disk Drive support stands ready for the latest storage technology while remaining compatible with today's most cost-effective and popular HDD solutions.
