1. Before installing the network/Internet modem/Router, you are strongly suggested to install an operational system first. The network/Internet modem/Router is provided with a CD-ROM.

2. Set the network/Internet settings on the modem/Router according to the computer's address settings (IP). Refer to the address, DNS, and DHCP settings on the network/Internet modem/Router user manual for more information on network/Internet settings on your PC.

**⚠ Note:** If your CD-ROM drive will not read the CD-ROM, do not attempt to fix it in the case scenario for your workstation address. This will probably cause a conflict.

1. Turn off your PC and remove the cover.
2. Insert the CD-ROM into the CD-ROM drive that you have in front of you. Make sure the cover is closed on the PC.
3. Plug your speaker system (the speaker jack, connected to the back of the case) into a convenient CD-ROM drive cabinet or surround sound if applicable. These cables are different with the CD-ROM drive.
4. Replace the cover on your PC and turn on the power.
5. If applicable, proceed with the installation of the software on your CD-ROM drive, and follow the instructions supplied with the drive.
6. Install the software supplied with your sound card. Proceed as follows:
7. Insert the CD into the CD-ROM drive and change to the program normally CD-ROM.

**⚠ Note:** Before installing the Windows 95 drivers, you first have to install the Windows 95 drivers for the CD-ROM drive.

8. Type "setup" to begin the installation and follow the on-screen instructions. (Do not connect your sound system. Type "CD-ROM", before proceeding with the installation.)

9. After completing the installation, choose "F to exit" if Windows 95 may not proceed with the installation of the required Windows 95 drivers.

**⚠ Note:** Installation of the software requires at least 1.5M RAM of conventional memory. Before proceeding, verify on your MS-DOS screen.
