The MS-6160 can be found with either Award and AMI BIOS versions. My board came with AMI (see BIOS sticker in photo). The stock AMI BIOS is very locked down and missing many options. I modified it to include the following options:

Onboard audio can now be enabled/disabled. Ideal for anyone using a proper ISA sound card to avoid conflicts.

CPU L2 cache can be disabled for speed sensitive games.

Overclocking options enabled. FSB frequency can now be changed between 66MHz/75MHz/83MHz.

IRQ options have been added to the PCI/Plug and Play menu.

Other basic options have been added to the other menus.

I've attached both the original AMI A61601 V1.2B1 BIOS (A61601.zip) and the modified BIOS (VS06160.zip).
